



Angela Jerabek is the Founder and Executive Director of BARR Center®, a nationally recognized non-profit organization that builds strong school communities that support student success by improving school culture, school climate and educator effectiveness.

Ms. Jerabek began her career in education as a licensed K-12 teacher, and a secondary school counselor in Minneapolis, Minnesota. She is an author, speaker and education innovator whose expertise lies in school improvement, equity, youth development, adolescent counseling and using data and evidence in schools. As the executive director of BARR Center, Angie provides thought leadership and operational oversight of the organization and the national network of BARR educators.

Developed by Jerabek in 1998, the BARR model (Building Assets, Reducing Risks) has been implemented throughout the United States with consistent results regardless of school type, size or location. In virtually every geographical location, the implementation of BARR has resulted in a statistically significant reduction in failure rates by an average of 34.5%, after just one year of implementation. Similarly, course credits earned increase, grade point averages improve, and the opportunity gap narrows when a school implements BARR. Tested and validated by the American Institutes for Research (AIR), BARR stands alone as the most consistently proven secondary school improvement model in the country.
